Someone is displaced every three seconds


That's how long it took you to read this.

26 million of them are refugees.

And **6.6 million** come from Syria.



10 years after the Syrian conflict began, refugees still struggle with poverty. And the communities that host them are affected too.

To support refugees and their hosts, we need to help conflict-affected communities.

Shelter, food, and donations are great short-term solutions. But ultimately, it's building a livelihood that really makes a difference.

The first step? Empowering refugees to build small businesses.



This will help them build a better life for themselves. And as they spend the money they earn, the communities who host them will thrive too.

A recent study in Lebanon found that for every \$1 spent, communities put \$2.60 back into the Lebanese economy.

But without the proper funding or support, it's difficult to get these businesses off the ground.



That's why we've joined forces with a group of committed partners to launch the Refugee Impact Bond.



The first phase of this project will help create up to 3,420 small businesses in Jordan--improving families' wellbeing and increasing their spend on basic needs by 17%.
